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Haifeng Wang received his Ph.D. in 2001 from Shanghai Institute of Optics and fine Mechanics (SIOM), Chinese Academy of Sciences (CAS). After his PhD, he first worked as a post doctoral research fellow in Delft University of Technology (TUDelft) and Free University of Amsterdam (VUA), the Netherlands, from 2001 to 2004, where he studied surface plasmon, optical wave guide, vector focusing and radially polarized light. He joined Data Storage Institute, Singapore in 2005 as a senior research fellow and became a Research Scientist in 2010. He is a full professor and director of the Institute of Imaging Optics at University of Shanghai for Science & Technology since 2013. His research topics cover a wide range, including Super-resolution imaging, non-diffracting beams, photon spin, abnormal optical polarization engineering, optical antennas, microwave photonics and optical/magnetic data storage. He is a member of the OSA and also holds the position of Guest Professor at the SIOM.
